The American Medical Association states that brain growth doesn't end until around age 20. The Underage Drinking Research Initiative at the National Institute on Alcohol Abuse and Alcoholism cites one study showing a "single, moderate dose of alcohol can disrupt learning more powerfully in people in their early twenties, compared with those in their late twenties."
